- Students cannot drop courses except for add/drop week in the beginning of the year.
- If students do not pass BEST ELA exams they will be placed in reading.
- To earn senior privilege students must be on track to graduate and pass at least one AP exam, industry certification exam, or earn a C+ in a Dual Enrollment course prior to 12th grade.
- All online classes must be completed by July 31st, 2023 to not appear on 23-24 schedule.
