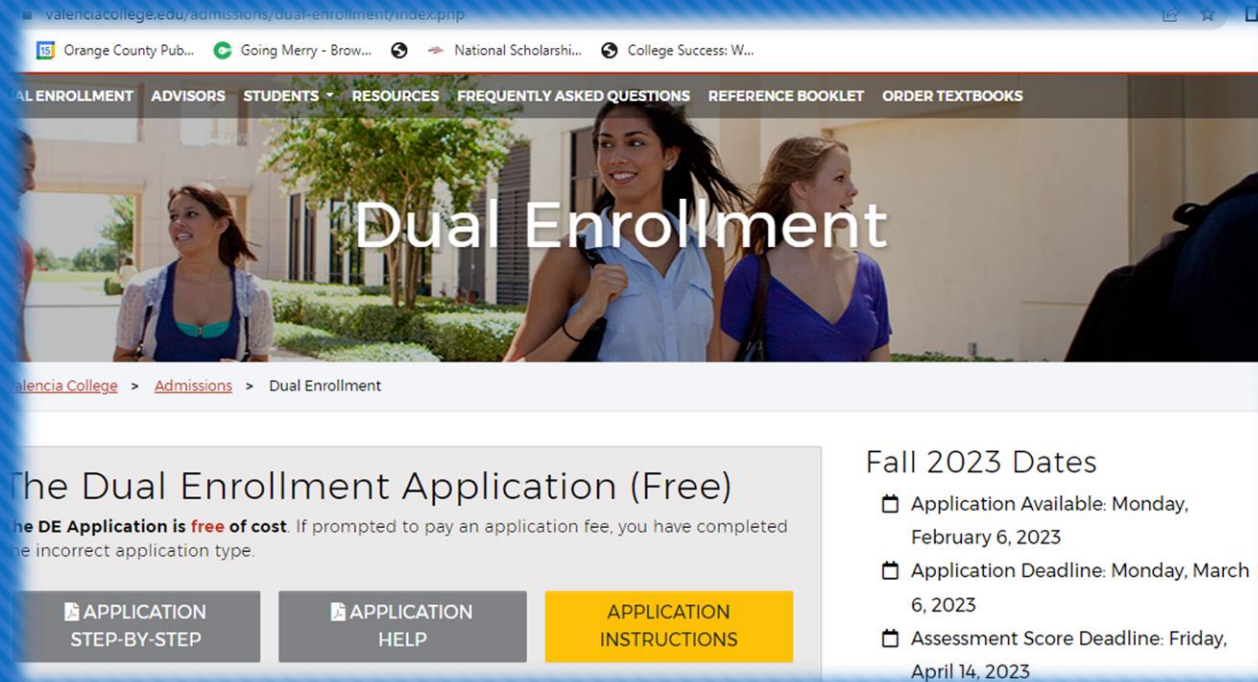

Academic Dual Enrollment: What is that?

VALENCIA COLLEGE

- Enrolled at Apopka and Valencia at the same time.
- Earn both high school credit and college credit simultaneously.
- If you are dual enrolled, you are a college student!

Benefits of Dual Enrollment

- Tuition is **FREE**. So are the textbooks!
- DE courses are weighted as 6.0, increase weighted GPA
- You can take classes online or at any Valencia campus
- Meeting high school requirements at same time as college requirements
- Head start of UCF Direct Connect (from Valencia)

WARNING!

Keep in Mind:

- Some universities tend to prefer AP over DE
- Not all universities accept dual enrollment credit (often top)
- You have to provide your own transportation (16+ years old)
- Beware of specific major requirements (**AA > Major**)
- **Students are beginning their college transcript**
- **These DE grades will remain in their college GPA & on their transcript after high school**
- **Poor grades can affect future college acceptance and financial aid**

Dual Enrollment sounds GREAT, but what classes should I take?

This will be different for every student

- 1) Do you have transportation?*
- 2) What college do you want to attend?*
- 3) What do you want to major in?*
- 4) What graduation requirements do you have remaining?*
- 5) Speak with your school counselor*
- 6) If you are unsure, start **slow***

How do I fit my DE classes into my high school schedule?



- You can take either part time or full time classes (1- 4 courses)
 - 4 courses is full time
- Your DE classes can also count as high school credits toward your graduation requirements
- Almost all graduation requirement courses can be taken solely at Valencia, **except:** HOPE, Algebra 1, Geometry, and World History

Dual Enrollment Requirements

Subject to change at start of application period

- 3.0 unweighted cumulative GPA (9th-11th)
 - Rising Seniors, 3.0 weighted cumulative GPA
 - Passing PERT (all sections)
- or
- Passing SAT/ACT
 - 16 years old to take courses on campus (unless escorted by parent)

Testing

○ SAT/ACT

- Must send official scores from SAT/ACT (www.collegeboard.org)
- May take up to 5 weeks to receive scores
- March school day SAT scores will not arrive in time

OR

○ PERT



- Sign up to take at Apopka on Feb 6th
 - <https://forms.gle/KnrciDnBf4XGjvBd8> also on CANVAS
- Can also go to Valencia to test after receiving VID #


Test Score Requirement

Scores subject to change each semester

Test Score Requirements

All students are required to submit and have college-ready test scores on file at Valencia College for reading, writing *and* math, by the deadline for the desired term of enrollment. ***Any combination of eligible scores (see below) will be accepted.***

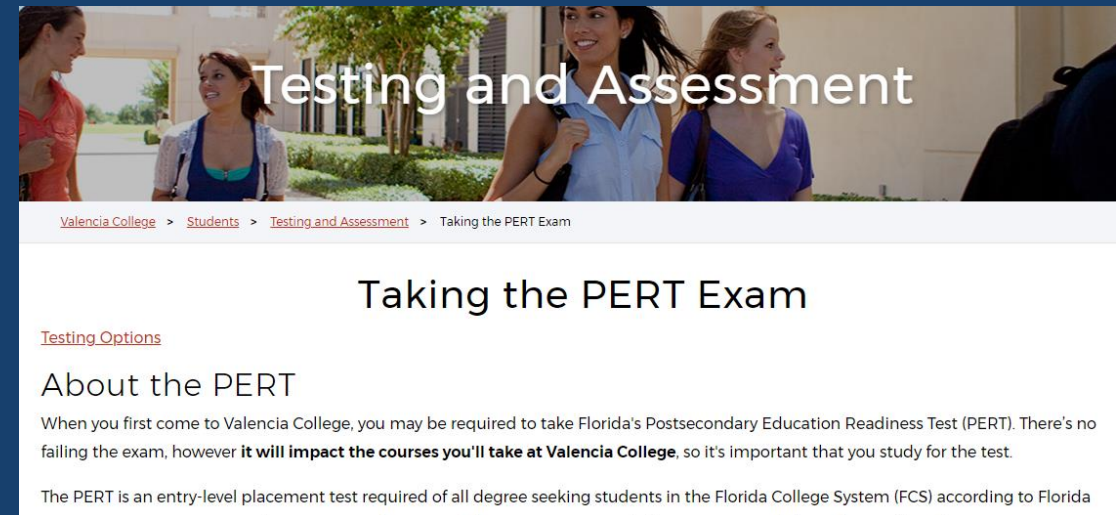

What if I don't pass the PERT?

- You can retest 2 more times at Valencia (with VID#)
 - Step 1: Complete your Dual Enrollment Application
 - Step 2: Get VID #
 - Step 3: Schedule & retake PERT at Valencia

Fall Deadline (August start date)

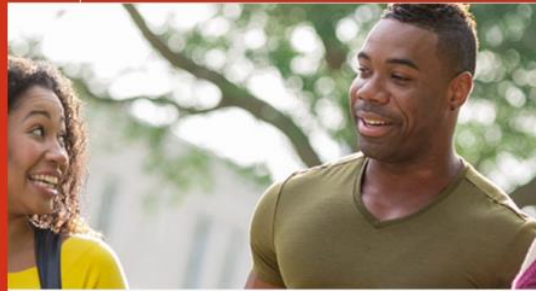
- Application opens: **Feb 6**
- Application closes: **March 6**
- Test Scores due by: **April 14**
- www.valenciacollege.edu/dual
- *Yes, you can apply BEFORE having passing test scores.*

Application Process



- 1) Visit valenciacollege.edu/dual and click on "Apply Now"
- 2) When prompted, create a Dynamic Forms account (underlined in blue after submitting)
- 3) Provide a parent/legal guardian's email address
- 4) Enter **school counselor's** full name and email address
 - 1) **Dual Enrollment Representative = School Counselor**
- 5) Parent and counselor will receive email to create dynamic form and submit their part

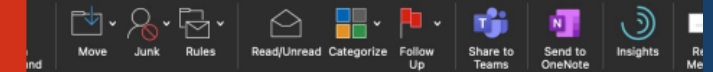

Once Accepted-

about 2 weeks after passing test scores received

- ❑ Log into your Atlas account- check your ATLAS often!
- ❑ Take Online Orientation in CANVAS (Valencia)
- ❑ Meet with school counselor to pick classes
- ❑ Register for classes (during your registration time)
- ❑ Give schedule to counselor
- ❑ Order Textbooks (through Valencia bookstore online)
- Remember: You can also schedule an appointment with a Dual Enrollment Advisor through Valencia!

NEW CHANGES

- All **current** Valencia students will be assigned a registration time ticket and will be notified via Atlas email (Valencia email) when they may register.
- All **new Valencia students** will be able to register **March 20th** for the fall semester. This includes newly accepted dual enrollment students for the fall 2023 cycle.
- ****Note: Newly accepted dual enrollment students may NOT sign up for summer session (updated by Valencia on 1/25)**


UCF Dual Enrollment



- 6th Through 12th grade
- 3.8 **Recalculated Core** GPA
- ACT 28 or SAT 1330 (no PERT)
- Fall Deadline to Apply: **May 1**
- Spring Deadline to Apply: **November 1**
- Summer Deadline to Apply: **March 1**
- Students can enroll in a maximum of **two classes** per term virtual or face-to face
- Students must re-apply to UCF after graduation if they wish to continue at UCF

- Only available for dual enrollment programs not offered at Valencia (career)
- Students must submit forms in person to one of their Success Specialists. Students can submit forms to specialists Mondays-Thursdays from 830p to 6p and Fridays from 9-4p.

- Students can meet with a Valencia Dual Enrollment advisor at any point regarding an AA degree.
- Check your ATLAS account frequently for emails from Valencia.
- After being accepted, you must take your Valencia Orientation before registering for classes.
- Students CANNOT sign up for FLEX courses, it will drop them.
